Source of Activity:

On 09-25-06 at 1230 hrs my partner (Ofcr Maxwell, A #32387) and I (Ofcr Habell, M #37532) were assigned Hollywood Div uniform patrol, unit 6A97, driving a marked blk and wht police vehicle. We received a station call of burglary investigation, RD #667, Incident #6268002025.

Investigation:

Upon our arrival at 1230 hours, we met with (R/S/D)-Gettinger who stated that someone had removed her property from her residence between 08-28-06 to 09-21-06. R/S/D stated that the several keys were also missing from her residence.

R/S/D stated that she kept a spare set of keys to her garage on a hook attached to the rear wooden fence. R/S/D stated she does not lock the rear gate attached to the wooden fence. R/S/D stated that she also kept a spare house key inside the detached garage. R/S/D stated that she noticed the keys were missing on 08-28-06 but did not make a police report for the missing keys.

R/S/D stated that she began to notice that some of her properties (misc personal records and paperwork) were missing from inside her residence but became alarmed when she failed to locate her property deed, \$3000 dollars and jewelry. R/S/D stated that she did not give permission to anyone to remove property from her residence.

Officers observed the location to be a two story apartment building and R/S/D's residence was located on the second story. A rear staircase leading into the R/S/D's residence was located to the west of the apartment building. The staircase is accessible via the rear wooden gate. We observed that the rear wooden gate was unlocked. There is a central rear courtyard also accessible to other occupants of the apartment building. We observed no evidence of force entry along the residence's doors and windows.

Our investigation revealed that the unk susp(s) removed the garage keys from the wooden fence and unlocked the garage. Susp(s) then took the house key from the garage and used it to gain entry into vict's residence. Once inside, susp(s) removed vict's property from the residence without permission. Susp(s) exited the residence with vict's property and fled the location in unknown direction.

I provided the victim with a Victims Property Loss Supplemental Report (3.4) for additional property if discovered missing. We checked the area for susp, witnesses, and evidence with negative results.

Vict stated she has not been on good terms with her daughter and son-in-law (Schmidt, Sylvia and Schmidt, Gary, 626-395-9737, 2371 Cumberland Rd, San Marino, CA 91108). Vict stated that her daughter had asked for the property deed and a power-of-attorney numerous times in the past but vict had refused.

Vict stated that her daughter and son-in-law knew the locations of the garage key and house key. Vict stated that she suspected her daughter and son-in-law were the persons who took her property without permission. Vict advised us that she contacted her daughter and asked her to return her property. Vict's daughter denied having the property in her possession and told the victim to contact the police.

During our investigation, we observed that the vict (F/Wht, 81 years old) possibly suffered from some memory loss.

Sid prints was not contacted due to the vict's touching/handling of items and the period of time since the incident occurred.
